

### How we are required to safeguard our children is changing...

Children are being exploited and harmed outside of their homes, by people not known to the family or by their peers. It is happening at a rapid pace and causing significant trauma to the children and young people, and their families. Schools and education providers have a fundamental role to play in safeguarding children & young people from harm.
