It is happening at a rapid pace and causing significant trauma to the children and young people, and their families. Schools and education providers have a fundamental role to play in safeguarding children & young people from harm.

Child sexual exploitation <u>IS</u> happening across the North-East...

It is essential that staff working in multi-agency services supporting children and young people have the understanding, knowledge, skills and confidence to spot the signs of abuse and exploitation and know what to do if they have concerns.

We need to build a network of CSE champions to ensure that protective structures are present and can be effectively mobilised to stop or disrupt exploitation. No matter what your profession, we all have a role to play in safeguarding children and young people from abuse.
